Over 2500 examinees expelled on 4th day

Over 2500 examinees were expelled on the fourth day of ongoing Secondary School Certificate (C) and Dakhil examinations Tuesday on charge of copying the examination halls. Bengali and paper examinations were held on the day.

Of the total the highest 1028 examinees were expelled from Rajshahi Board, 321 from Dhaka Board, 308 from Comilla Board, 119 from Chittagong Board, 105 from Jessore Board, 21 from Sylhet Board and 323 from Madrasah Board.

Over 30 teachers were also expelled during the examinations on Tuesday for helping students in copying inside the examination

halls.

Sixteen teachers were expelled from Rajshahi Board. Of them, 11 teachers were expelled from different centres in Nawabganj district while two each from Lamoni and Dinajpur districts.

Our Comilla Correspondent adds: Four teachers—two high school teachers and two madrasah teachers—were expelled from Comilla and Chandpur districts under the board for assisting the student in copying.

Thirty madrasah students were also expelled from different centres under the board during the examinations on Tuesday.

So far, over 18500 examinees were expelled in four examinations.
