

## 'Poor english, math knowledge, main cause of SSC failure'

Poor knowledge of students on English and Mathematics is the main cause for low pass rate in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations, said Chairman of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board, Comilla Prof M Atiqur Rahman.

"Most of the unsuccessful students in SSC examinations do not pass in English and Mathematics. Now it is a crisis in the schools of rural areas where efficient teachers on English and Mathematics are not available," he said while addressing as the chief guest at the 82nd founding anniversary of GM Hat High School at Fhulgaji in Feni on Thursday.

He suggested the caretaker government to recruit talented teachers especially for English and Mathematics.
