The Education Adviser said the government has some discretion-ary power and it has exercised that authority to release the teachers and students from jail. "The President has given them a suo motto mercy.

He said the caretaker government's main responsibility is to hold a general election and hand over power to an elected govern-ment. "That's why we're careful so that the main target is not affected in any way. So, the issue has been settled amicably

The Education Adviser, however, said this was a learnable incident and it should be analysed to take lessons from it.

Dr Zillur said somebody can analyse the matter from different points of view, but the govern-ment has considered it with a sympathetic attitude.

He said all the 10 cases filed under Emergency Power Rules (EPRs) implicating the teachers and students have been with-

But, he said, only one case still remains pending in which a total of 25 people were implicated and now the number of accused have been reduced to 7 from the 25. "This case will be resolved soon and it'll be considered under the
