Special workplan taken to develop madrasha edn

CHITTAGONG, Apr 10: Minister for Labour and Employment M A Mannan today said that the present government had undertaken special work plan for development of madrasa education alongside the general education, reports BSS.

Addressing the foundation laying ceremony of Ahmedia Karimia Sunnia Fazil Madrasa at East Bakalia here as chief guest, the minister said that the government has made the highest allocation for the education sector.

Presided over by founder of the madrasa Sona Mia Sawdagar, the foundation laying ceremony was attended by city Awami League leaders and local elite.

Listing various projects undertaken by the government of Sheikh Hasina in education, health and communication sectors and infrastructure development in Chittagong, the labour minister said, no government after 1975 had initiated such development programmes in the region.

The minister also said that as many as 7,000 development projects have been implemented in Chittagong during the last two and a half years.

Earlier, the minister inaugurated the new building of Bakalia High School financed by the Wage Earners Welfare Fund and later laid the foundation stone of East Bakalia Girls High School.
