

JCD activists set ablaze eight vehicles

Pro-BNP students went on rampage on Monday at the campuses of Dhaka University, Dhaka College and BUET following the news of Tarique Rahman sustaining injury in custody, reports UNB.

At the Dhaka University, the JCD activists, who were holding a meeting near Aparajeyo Bangla demanding release of Khaleda Zia and Tarique Rahman at noon on Monday, got enraged hearing that Tarique Rahman was injured as he

slipped in the bathroom of the BSMMU Hospital.

The JCD activists rushed en masse, to Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical Hospital (BSMMU) at about 12:25 pm.

As police halted the rowdy activists near the hospital, they went berserk and threw brickbats towards the law enforcers.

After a chase and counter-chase between the students and the police, the students while return-

ing to the campus damaged five vehicles and set fire to a black taxicab in front of Fine Arts Institute and Rokeya Hall.

Violence also erupted at the Dhaka College campus when the JCD activists took to the street hearing the injury news of Tarique Rahman. They also ransacked two vehicles.

The pro-BNP activists at the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) campus also staged protest.
