

// DU provost among 10 injured

JCD-BCL activists clash over soccer match

Ten people, including the provost of Zahurul Haque Hall of Dhaka University, were injured in a clash between the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal, in the dormitory Saturday, reports UNB.

The injured were identified as hall provost Prof. Zahidul Islam, JCD activists Rakibuzzaman, Shahjada, Faysal, Rokon and Atahar, and BCL activists Mazhar, Ashraf, Nayan, Ruhul and Rahat.

Three of the injured students were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

Campus sources said the clash broke out over a football match held between JCD activists of the 3rd and 4th years of the hall and senior leaders of JCD's DU unit.

After the football match, several hundreds of JCD activists from various dormitories gathered at the Zahurul Haq Hall.

BCL leaders of the hall unit complained to the hall authorities that JCD has gathered a good number of workers to destabilise the campus situation.

"While the BCL leaders were talking to the hall provost, the JCD activists swooped on the BCL men with iron rods and hockey sticks," said a spot account.

Soon after the incident, the

clash spilled into the entire dormitory areas, leaving the 10 people injured. The hall provost suffered serious injuries in his hands and face.

Vice-chancellor Prof. Dr. SMA Faiz and Proctor Dr. AKA Hifoz accompanied by over 200 cops later visited the hall.

Meanwhile, the university authorities formed two committees—one to probe the attack on the hall provost and another to investigate the clash.
