



## Hunger strike of foreign students in Sher-e-Bangla College ends

BARISAL, Nov 9.—Foreign students of Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hostel, who went on a hunger strike following a conflict over eating beef, broke their hunger strike Friday night after intervention by the authorities, says UNB.

Fourteen Nepalese and Indian students of the hostel went on hunger strike Friday morning demanding security after an attack on them allegedly by other foreign students.

They alleged that some Pakistani and Nepalese Muslim students beat up one Indian and two Nepalese students Thursday night following a quarrel over eating beef at the hostel.

Academic Council of the college will sit in a meeting tomorrow (Sunday) to review the present situation in the hostel and trace the students responsible for the incident.

A total of 40 foreign students live at the hostel and of them eight each from India and Pakistan, and 24 from Nepal. Of the Nepalese students, 13 are Muslims.
