## **New private university to be launched in September**

State University of Bangladesh (SUB), a new private university, is going to launch its academic activities in September this year.

The university got the government approval on May 30 recently. At the initial level it would start with three departments—Business Administration and Management, Computer and Information Technology, and Computer Engineering.

The commissioning programme was held at a city hotel recently. Former chairman of University Grants Commission (UGC) and proposed Vice Chancellor of SUB Prof Iazuddin Ahmed hoped it would be a centre of excellence in the teaching arena.

The members of the university's governing body—Former chairman of Public Service Commission (PSC) Prof SMA Fayez, Dr Abul Bayes Bhuiyan, AM Shamim, and Mahbubur Rahman Liton—were present at the programme.
