Southeast varsity to launch 3 new courses

Through a simple but intellectually stimulating ceremony at its own premises Southeast University declared its readiness to launch three post-graduate diplomas in Islamic Banking and Insurance, Economics and Management of NGO Affairs, International Economics and Institutions (WTO, World Bank and IMF), and a certificate course in Research Methodology.

The occasion was chaired by Afzal Hossain, Chairman of South Asia Foundation. The meeting was attended by a number of top executives of several banks and insurance companies.

In his welcome address Prof. Dr. Salahuddin Ahmad, Professor of Economics and Dean of Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences expounded the course outlines of the various diploma programme and highlighted their role in developing professional manpower in Bangladesh. Professor Dr. M.
