Vice Chancellor of Darul Ihsan University Prof Dr MA Hamid died at a hospital in Chicago in the United States Monday night. He was 63, reports UNB.

Prof Hamid, a former Vice Chancellor of Islamic University and professor in Economics Department of Rajshahi University, had been suffering from lung cancer.
