War ming against bid to disrupt peace

President and Chief Martial Law Idministrator Lt. Gen. H.M. Ershad on Saturday war ned the nation of the fresh move being initiated by politi cal parties to create law and order situation in the country on the plea of a political move ment.

Addissing the first national convention of the Federation of Teachers Associations (FTA) at Mahakhali the President laid that the nation could he more afford any chaos and anarchy He urged all to restit effort from any quar ter to foment indiscipline in the society. He exhorted the people, to work unitedly and with dedication for building a new' Hangiadesh.

Emphasising the importance of the teaching community the President said that the teachers were the builders of the future of the country. He advised the teacheds to play their due role in the society by educating the nation.

The President advised all not to pollite the academic atmos phere. He said that the students were the future of the nation and none should try to deviate them from their pursuit of knowledge He asked the temchers to keep their studenti disciplined and dalicated # their studies.

Reiterating his Government's policy o establish Islamic ideals in all spheres of national life President Ershad announced that religious education whuld be made compulsory from the current academic year He expressed his regret official decision to make religious education optional in the current curricula saying, "I did not know how it happened". When he gave this announcement the Madrast a teachers cheered and raised sogans," We want Isla mic revolution".

Referring to different demands of the teachers President En had, who is also the Chairma, of the Federation of Teachers Associations said "I pledge to establish you in the society with full honour and status". He announced amidst cheers that the teachers would now get Taka 100 per month as house rent and he ordered to implement time-scale promotion for teachers from the current bonth.

President Ershad said that he was Lappy to be the Chair man of he FTA "I am your Chairman not by force", he told the lhousands of teachers who confereged at the national convention of

About the demands of the teachers he said that from now on trained graduate teachers would enjoy Second Class gazet ted officers status in their travel and daily allowances. He announced that teachers in non-Government educational institutions would get the amount equivalent to yearly increment as grant from the current month. The Head Mohaddes of Qamel Madrasa would be given the status of assistant Professor of Govern ment college, he added.

President Ershad said that he had granted Taka ten lakh for supplying food to the dele. gates in the teachers convention.

Steps will be taken for appointment of eligible demonstra. tors in the pay scale of 625-1315 as Lecturer in the Govern ment collages.

Eighty per cent of the post of Professor Associate Professor and Assistant Professor in Government colleges will be filled un through promotions. As a result of this step 2 000 teach. ers will be promoted soon.

The experience of the teachers in the non-Government edu. cational institutions will be counted from the date the institution concerned received recognition from proper authori. ties.

The ratio of Lecturers and Assistant Professors have been made 6:3 from 5:2. As a result most of the lecturers will be able to enjoy 1400-2225 pay sca. le after completing eight years of service

Eligible teachers of non-Government educational institutions will be appointed deputation as per 20 per cent rule.

If any person with Second Class Honuours and Masters degrees was a school teacher and later appointed as college teachers his service length will be determined by adding his experience in the school with

Break of service up to six months will be treated as continuity of service in case of the teachers of non-Government educational institutions when they get appointment from one institution to the other

The matter of exemption of Income-Tax of the non-Govern ment teachers has been sent to the national board of Revenue for consideration

Government , pay scale will ; be introduced for Class Three and Four employees of non-Government educational institutions. Similary appropriate pav scale will be introduced for the "Kabbyatihtha" teach. CT2

If any educational institution is functioning on the vested and abandoned lands and if that land is not required for any important programme of the Government then that land may be allotted in favour of the concerned institution as per law if it is found logical.

The Iftedayen class of teachers attached with Dhakil mad. rasas will be given necessary grants as per Government pay «cale.

Directive have already been given to appoint subject-wise lecturers in the madrassa

The allowance for the Karris of Forkania madrasas will be restored with immediate effect.
