33 more fake students identified at DU

The fact-finding committee that has been working for detecting fake students at the Dhaka University (DU), on Monday identified 33 more students, who got admitted through fraudulent means, reports BSS.

The committee, at its eighth meeting with pro-vice-chancellor Professor AFM Yusuf Haider in the chair identified the fake students.

Of the 33 fake students, 30 got admitted to the Public Administration Department and three to the Applied Chemistry Department. The committee will send showcase notices to them, according to sources.

The fact-finding committee also recommended cancellation of admissions of earlier identified 13 more fake students by the university syndicate, the sources said.

The committee, headed by Pro-VC Prof AFM Yusuf Haider, has so far identified 180 fake students since its formation on October 10, 2006. Meanwhile, the syndicate cancelled admissions of 167 students out of 180, the pro-VC told BSS.

The committee was formed in the wake of allegations of inconsistencies in the admission papers of 11 students of the Public Administration Department of the 2004-05 academic session.

A drive was launched in March this year to find out fake students in the faculties of Arts and Social Sciences following the probe committee's report on forgery in the admission.
