

Consultative body in Ministry of Education

A Consultative Committee has been formed in the Ministry of Education with the Minister in charge of the Ministry as chairman to ensure smooth functioning of educational institutions and promote better understanding and communication between the teaching community and the authorities says a PID handout.

The other members of the committee are:

Two members of the Ministry of Education; two officers from the Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education; two representatives of Bangladesh Government College Teachers' Association; two representatives of Bangladesh non-Government College Teachers' Association; two representatives of Bangladesh Government Teachers' Association; two representatives of Bangladesh Teachers Association; two representatives of Bangladesh Madrasah Teachers' Association; two representatives of Teachers of Primary Training Institute; two officers from Primary Education Directorate and two representatives of Primary Teachers' Association.

The committee will advise the Government on the smooth functioning of the educational institutions and suggest measures for improvement of the teaching standard and teachers training. It will also suggest ways and means to reduce incidence of failure in public examination and prevention of unfair means in the public examinations and advise the Government on the proper utilisation of resources in the education sector.

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
