Introduction of Education Service Commission demanded

The executive body of the Bangladesh Principals' Council (BPC), in a meeting on Saturday, demanded immediate introduction of the proposed "Education Service Commission" to give appointment and promotion to the non-government college teachers.

They also demanded the appointment of the non-government college teachers to the posts related to the examinations under the National University and the Education Boards.

The other demands of the council include implementation of 100 per cent government portion of the salary restructuring the National University governing body to conduct the academic and administrative activities of the colleges.

Other than the demands relating to the interests of the teachers, the BPC also urged both the government and the oppositions to be more patient and considerate.

The meeting, presided over by the President of BPC Professor M.
