

6 injured in BCL-JCD clash at JnU

AT LEAST six Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal activists were hurt when a group of Bangladesh Chhatra League activists attacked their rally in front of the Liberation War sculpture on the Jagannath University campus on Monday.

The injured were identified as Rakibul Islam, Al-Ashraf Mamun, Faruk Ahmed, Sumon and Mohammad Shawon and botany department student Tania Sultana Sathi.

The police detained JnU JCD unit joint-secretary Al Ashraf Mamun and its activist Abdullah Al Noman from the spot.

Witnesses said that about a hundred JCD activists had brought out a procession on the JnU campus at around 11:00am in protest at 'irregularities' in the university administration. After the procession, the JCD activists were preparing to hold a rally

in front of the Liberation War sculpture but police stopped them.

Shortly afterwards, a group of BCL men attacked the JCD activists leaving six

of them injured.

JnU proctor Ashok Kumar Saha along with law enforcers went to the spot and calmed the situation.

JCD's JnU unit president

Faisal Ahmed threatened to enforce strike at the university if the authorities did not take action against the BCL activists responsible for the attack.
