NOW a day Kinder (KG) system of education has been playing a significant role in expanding education among the children of the country. In fact most of the KG authorities of the country are following the International Standard of KG education. The reason is that some of the school authorities have no idea about the education system they think that the aim of this system of education is to lay importance on English and help acquiring knowledge of various subjects including general knowledge and drawing with text book approved by the government for primary education. Some of the KG school founders conduct the schools to gain profit like the trading concerns.

According to the International Standard of this system, children are taught by putting importance on extra-curricular activities like playing, songs drawing etc. KG is the first introduction of children to schools KG is an acronym of two German words Kinder and Garten. The German word Kinder means child and Garten means Garden. Here Kinder Garten or KG means Child's Garden. Here children are considered as saplings of garden schools as gardens and teachers as gardeners.

Friedrich Froebel, a German Educator developed the Kinder Garten system of education in 1837. The aim of the Kinder Garten curriculum developed by Froebel are the cultivation of the child's self-development, self-activity and socialization. It includes songs, stories, games, gifts and occupation. The songs, stories and games generally are a part of early childhood education, to stimulate the child's imagination and to introduce the child to the customs, heroes and ideas of cultural heritage. Games provide the cooperative activity that socializes children and develop their physical and motor skills.

As the boys and girls play with other children, they become part of the group and are prepared for further group learning activities. As they play various games, they also develop coordination and physical dexterity.

The gifts consisted of objects whose form was fixed, such as spheres, cubes and cylinders. The occupations of the Kinder Garten consisted of materials that could be shaped by the children and used in designs and construction activity. For example, clay, sand, cardboard and mud could be manipulated and shaped into castles, cities and mountains.

The combination of the said activities will create a good environment for learning of the children who like saplings of the garden will grow naturally and correctly, if the real system of KG is in force.
