

Students deprived quality education

KG schools lack formulated policy in Mymensingh

MYMENSINGH, May 21:— The students of Kindergarten Schools (K.G. School) of the district are being deprived of proper education as these schools are being run according to their own curriculum instead of international Curriculum or standard.

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There are 120 K.G. Schools including Nursery Schools and Pre-cadet Schools and three English medium schools in the district. None of these schools is registered or recognised by the government.

Lack of well formulated policy for Kindergarten Schools has prevented the quality of education in this sector to remain on an even keel. Only three English medium schools located at the district town are very much of an international standard but the quality of education is only occasionally exemplary in the
