



Achievement of Bangladeshi girl in US

Nusrat Geety Chowdhury, a Bangladeshi girl studying in School in America, has been nominated for Who's Who Among American High School Students. Only the highest achieving students in high school are considered for this honour.

The biography of Geety will be published in this prestigious Who's Who and will be distributed to around 15,000 colleges, high schools and youth groups. This honour is selected from only five per cent top achievers and has traditionally been of great value. The nominee will qualify for one of several scholarships totalling 200,000 dollar.

Geety is the daughter of Mesbahuddin Chowdhury who was a journalist in Dhaka before migrating to USA and Lucky Chowdhury, manager of Wendy's in Stafford, Virginia. She is the niece of Abu Zafar Panna, Executive Editor of the News Today, who guided Geety when she was in Bangladesh.
