

Bangladesh researcher wins UNESCO Award

AHM Shamsul Muktadir, a Bangladeshi researcher, has recently won the prestigious UNESCO/Keizo Obuchi Research Fellowship Award in the field of Peaceful Conflict Resolution on his proposed topic "Conflict Management between Bangladesh and Pakistan: Finding Ways of Greater Cooperation" for a period of nine months, says a Press release.

The award has been given by the UNESCO Headquarters in Paris from the Keizo Obuchi Japan Funds-in-Trust Project al-



ter rigid scrutiny and tough competition among applications received from all the UNESCO's 189 member countries. Only 20 fellowship winner awards are offered worldwide under this scheme annually to the "People Building the Next Era" as described by UNESCO. The trust is named after the late Prime Minister of Japan Mr. Keizo Obuchi who was famous for his great interest in peaceful resolution of international disputes.
