6 win UNESCO, ISESCO fellowships

Six Bangladeshis have won United Nations Educational Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) and Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ISESCO) fellowships and prizes, reports UNB.

Dr. Azharul Islam, Professor of Physics at Rajshahi University, has won ISESCO prize in Physics. It carries 5,000 US dollars and an ISESCO certificate.

Hasina Akter, Scientific Officer of Institute of Food and Radiation Biology, has been selected for a fellowship under UNESCO-L'OREAL Cosponsored Fellowships for Young Women in life science 2002. Duration of the fellowship is 12 months and the grant amount is about 10,000 US dollars, said a Press release.

Besides, MA Saïek has been awarded Grand Prix Prize while Monira Morshed Munni Okamoto prize and Minhaj Mustakim Saki ACCU prize.

Jahanara Begum has won UNESCO Craft Prize in recognition of his outstanding contribution to creative use of dyed indigo thread for embroidery. His prize carries 1000 US dollars and a certificate, the release added.
