SAVAR. Apr 9:—Jahangirnagar University Teachers
Association (JUTA) has
suspended the on-going movement following the assurance
from the government to the demands of the striking teachers.
Earlier, JUTA suspended its
movement twice following the
assurance by the government.

JUTA began its movement
first in September, last year to
implement, its demands including VC-panel election. However
with the suspension of the ongoing movement, 18-day stalemate ends today.
