

Nizami's entry into JU campus protested

SAVAR, May 5:—Hundreds of teachers and students of Jahangirnagar University today (Monday) brought out a silent procession protesting the entry of Agriculture Minister Maulana Matiur Rahman Nizami on the campus.

Besides, 102 teachers of the university gave a joint statement expressing concern over the administration's relation with the 'war-criminals'. They also, expressed solidarity with the students who intercepted the motorcade of the Agriculture Minister and compelled to change the way to leave the campus immediately.

The huge procession of the teachers and students, beginning from Social Science Faculty at 10.30 am today ended at the Registrar Building protesting the entry of Agriculture Minister Maulana Matiur Rahman Nizami on the campus on Sunday.

The students today also burnt an effigy of Maulana Nizami at Amar Ekushey.

It may be mentioned here that Agriculture Minister Maulana Nizami who is also the Amcer of Jamaat-e-Islami entered the campus while giving a visit at Gerua village, adjacent to the university.

The students at that time tied down before the motorcade, which compelled him to leave the campus changing the way.
