BDR raid 12 DU halls

Police and Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) raided all the 12 male halls of Dhaka University on Saturday midnight.

Some 4.000 member of police, BDR and DB police conducted the raid simultaneously in all the halls but failed to recover any firearms or ammunition. or ammunition.

During the raid, police could not arrest any terrorists, though there is an allegation of staying terrorists in halls.

Additional Commissioner of police, Manjurul Kader 'led the raid. Police sources said, 12-deputy commissioner and 52 platoon of police joined the raid.

According to sources, some four thousand police and BDR started the block raid at Zero hour of Sunday. At that time police put up barricade at all the entrance point of the university including Shahbag, Nilkhet, Chankharpul and Doyel Square. Police did not allow anybody to enter or exit the university area during the four hour long raid.
