

## **DUTA concerned over recognition of Quami madrasa certificates**

The Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) expressed its deep concern and surprise at the unilateral decision of the government to equate results of different types of educational programmes with university degrees, reports D News.

Terming the decision of the government unethical and motivated, DUTA said such a decision would create an anarchy and disorder in the education arena of the country.

DUTA opined that the government has declared its decision in this regard without proper analysis, threadbare discussions and thorough scrutiny of the concerned educational system, its curriculum and period, type of education and its status and practical value.

Subsequent to this decision the education system as a whole as well as intellectual exercise will be severely hampered and the nation would become talentless and dependent on others, it added.
