

118 DU teachers condemn bid to tarnish image of Bangladesh

Some 118 teachers of Dhaka University on Friday condemned the bid by a certain quarter at home and abroad to tarnish the liberal image of Bangladesh, reports UNB.

In a statement, they said the quarter has been trying to demonstrate Bangladesh as an ultra communal country. This evil force did not limit their activities within propaganda and supplying false information abroad but also committed anti-human barbarous activities.
