### Movement against new JCD body faces split

CHITTAGONG, Oct 16:—The movement against the new convening committee of Chittagong City unit of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) faced a serious setback today as some rebel leaders expressed solidarity to the new committee.

A group of rebel leaders of Chittagong City JCD under the leadership of Tinku Das in a written statement lent their support to the new convening committee. Selim Khan, Ahmedul Huq and Shahed Akbar were the other among the signatories.

On the other hand, Bakalia, Polytechnic Institute, Bandar and Panchlaish unit of JCD continuing their movement against the new committee.

No procession and rally were held today at the central JCD office.
