Some of coaching centres in the . ing many strategies to attract of city are spinning crores of Takas from the students in the name of cooperation in admission in the top public universities of the country including Dhaka Univer-

sity, Jahangirnagar University, Medical Colleges and BUET. Some of the coaching centres were found responsible for fake admissions in DU. These coaching centres run a strong racket in the county. In Dhaka City, the racket is well connected. It includes teachers and students.

the students in selling their substandard coaching services. Normally, the activities of these coaching centres start providing coaching after the HSC examina-

According to sources, they contact over telephone the GPA-5 achievers and request them to enroll their names in their centres. They offer them free coaching and sometimes gift computers as part of the strategy. And in marketing of those coaching products, they hire Dhaka University students.

They also contact teachers houses and manage them for getting them some students. They collect photographs of the brilliant students who qualified in the DU and BUET admission and use them in their brochures to attract freshers. Their photograph collection involves financial dealings.

An investigation revealed that University Coaching Centre (UCC) has printed photograph of a student Abu Naser Mohammad Saif in their prospectus who secured 32nd position in the admission (Sec Page 15 Col. 6)

test of Ga unit in 2006-2007 academic session of DU. The same photograph was printed in the prospectus of the Dhaka Coaching Centre.

In the same way, photographs of many others were printed by these two coaching centres simultaneously.

The case is same with 'Shuvec-chha' Coaching Centre and 'Nu-cleus' Coaching Centre. Both the coaching centres owned one Nazneen Ara Rozi who secured top position in DU admission

On the other hand, 'Observe' Coaching Centre printed a photograph of a student in their prospectus who secured 13th posi-tions in the admission test of Gha unit of DU. But UCC coaching centre claimed that these students qualified from their centres

According to the coaching centres, the students admitted in 2006-2007 academic session in DU are 551 from UCC coaching centre, 1,346 from Focus coaching centre, 775 from Uni Aid coaching centre. 761 from Leads coaching centre. 310 from Positron coaching centre. 252 from Dhaka coaching centre, 851 from Omeca coaching centre. Of the total, more than 6,000 students were admitted to DU. But the total seats of four units (Ka, Kha, Ga and Gha) of DU

is 4,433.

The admission fee of these coaching centres is Taka.7, 000 compared to last year's Taka 6000.

These coaching centres enroll 3000 to 4000 students every year.
