

## Govt restricts setting up edn instts after names of nat'l leaders

The government restricted setting up educational institutions after the names of national leaders, including Bangabandhu, without Prime Minister's approval, reports UNB.

"Private initiators have to apply to Education Ministry with necessary documents for establishing educational institutions (school, college and Madrasah) after the nationally recognized leaders, dead or alive, including Father of the Nation Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, his family members, four national lead-

ers, seven Birshreshthas, language martyrs of February 21 (1952)," said an official notification Wednesday.

After reviewing the applications the ministry would pass on those to the Prime Minister for the seal of approval.

Private educational institutions could be named after the names of the leaders only after getting the nod from the head of government, according to the notification.

"No money will be required for such naming," said the notification.
