

Comilla Univ withdraws order on sending teacher on forced leave

COMILLA University authorities on Monday withdrew its order that send mass communication and journalism teacher Mahbubul Haque Bhuiyan on forced leave for a month for reportedly taking class on the National Mourning Day.

The university administration made the decision amid widespread protests of students.

University registrar Mujibur Rahman on confirmed the decision, but did not give any reason as to the change in its order.

On August 17, Mahbubul was sent to forced leave in response to a demand of the university unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League, ruling Awami League-backed students' organisation.

Terming Mahbub a 'traitor' BCL in an application to the vice-chancellor said that Mahbub had maligned the honour of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman by taking a class on the Mourning Day.

BCL also demanded that the teachers should be expelled from the university within 24 hours.
