

College teacher jailed in cheque fraudulence case

A TRIAL court in Rajshahi on Tuesday sentenced a college teacher to seven-year jail in a Tk 4 crore cheque fraudulence case.

The convict was identified as Shirin Sufia, a social

work department teacher of Rajshahi College.

Joint Metropolitan Judge Shariful Islam found her guilty of the charge and pronounced the verdict in her presence.

On October 4, 2014, her younger brother Obaidul Muktedir lodged a case

against Shirin Sufia with the Boalia police. After completing investigation, police pressed charges accusing Shirin Sufia.

Advocate Saidur Rahman Khan conducted the case on behalf of the plaintiff while Advocate Bishwajit defended the accused.
