

Non-MPO teachers, staff issue ultimatum

THE non-MPO Shikkha Pro-tisthan Shikkhak Karmachari Parishad on Thursday gave the government until April 30 to bring their educational institutions under the monthly pay order system.

'If the demand is not met, we will go for tougher movement from May 7,' the association's president Milan Kumar Ghoshal told a press conference in Dhaka.

The movement would involve programmes ranging from work abstention to staging demonstrations across the country, said the leader

of the association, a platform of non-MPO educational institutions' teachers and employees.

The association's general secretary Anwar Hossain, Swadhinota Shikkhak Parishad general secretary Shahjahan Alam Shaju, and teachers Osman Ghani, Abdul Khaleque, and Alimuz-zaman Jewel spoke at the conference.

They said that the government should take immediate steps to end sufferings of the teachers at over 5,200 educational institutions where they did not get salary and other benefits.
