COPYING DAKHIL EXAM QUESTIONS

Seven madrassah teachers held

POLICE detained seven madrassah teachers for making copies of Dakhil examination questions and preparing answers for sale at Bakerganj upazila town in Barisal district on Sunday.

The detainees were examination centre secretary of the Islamia Dakhil Madrassah Mawlana Bashiruddin and its teachers Mawlana Nuruzzaman, Maulana Jasim Uddin, Maulana Abu Hanif, Maulana Mehdi Hasan, Maulana Abdus Salam and Anwar Hossain, said district superintendent of police S M Aktaruzzaman.

Tipped-off that answers were being prepared for Sunday's exam question papers to be sold at Maulana Mustafizur Rahman's house, detective branch of district police raided Rahman's house at Runsi area of the municipal town.

The police recovered questions and answers of history and physics papers from their possession which were identical to the questions of Dakhil examinations held on Sunday.

Four of the teachers were held from Rahman's house and the rest were detained from the madrassah, said the district SP.

The matter was out of the jurisdiction of mobile court and so a regular case would be filed in this connection, said upazila nirbahi officer of Bakerganj Joynul Abedin.
