

QUESTIONS LEAK Natore pry schools' exams postponed

AUTHORITIES have postponed final examinations of mathematics of grade I and IV at 102 government primary schools under Sadar upazila in Natore on Monday following the reported question papers leakage.

Acting district primary education officer Anwar Hossain said Monday's examinations of Mathematics were postponed after a person showed a hand-written question paper at Agdigha Government Primary School prior to beginning the examination.

It matched with the real question paper that created a row in the area, the DPEO said, adding that on information, upazila administration and education officers visited the spot. Deputy commissioner of the district later formed a three-member probe body, headed by assistant commissioner (Land) in Sadar upazila Shamim Bhuiyan, to investigate into the matter.
