Student demos continue for registration

CLASSES, examinations and administrative activities at the University of Science and Technology Chittagong remained suspended on Tuesday for the seventh consecutive day in the face of continued demonstrations by the university's MBBS students, demanding their registrations under Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council.

Students from three batches demonstrated in front of the university on Tuesday from 11:00am to 12:30pm.

Professor Ehteshamul Hoque, dean of medicine faculty, told New Age that no classes and examinations had been held since January 10 due to the demonstrations.

University registrar Badrul Alam Bhuiyan told New Age that they were trying to resolve the issues through negotiations with the BMDC.

The BMDC has denied registrations to over 1,000 students from the 25th, 26th

and 27th MBBS batches of the university, due to a violation of admission rules by the university.
