

JU admission test begins today

THE admission test for the first year honours courses under academic sessions 2017-18 of Jahangirnagar University will begin today, which will continue until October 17.

A total of 151 candidates will vie for each seat this year.

The admission management committee said a total of 2,99,171 students would vie for 1986 seats under 6

faculties and 3 institutes this year.

Among the faculties, the largest number of applications had been submitted to the D unit under Biological Science faculty while Institute of Information and Technology got the largest number of applications among the institutes, the committee said.

For the first time, a mobile court would monitor the examination to prevent forgery

in the test, JU proctor professor Tapan Kumar Saha said.

According to the schedule, the admission test of A unit will be held on October 8 and 9, I unit on October 9, D unit on Oct 10 and 11, C unit on 12, B unit and G unit on 15, E unit and H unit on 16 and F unit on October 17.
