Pry school headmasters urge to end salary discrepancy

BANGLADESH Government Primary School Teachers Association on Monday urged finance minister AMA Muhith to end discrepancy in their salary structure.

The association led by its acting president Waise Ahmed Chowdhury made the appeal during a meeting with Muhith at the secretariat in the capital.

The association leaders alleged that salary of many headmasters and assistant teachers had become equal.


They said finance division did not consider the government announcement made in 2014 to give higher grade to the primary school headmasters.

Prime minister Sheikh Hasina gave the announcement to promote the job of the headmasters, they added.

Muhith told reporters after the meeting that they would examine the allegations raised by the association.

It would take time, he said.

The meeting was attended, among others, by primary and mass education minister Mostafizur Rahman and acting secretary Mohammad Asif-uf-Zaman and finance division secretary Hadayetullah Al Mamun.
