

BCL brings out procession defying ban on RU campus

LEADERS and activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League, student wing of the ruling Awami League, on Monday brought out a procession and organised a rally on Rajshahi University campus for the second consecutive day, defying the university authorities' restriction on holding such programmes during admission test.

They also announced that on the occasion of the first year admission test, they would hold such programmes on the university campus for the next three days.

Around three hundred BCL leaders and activists led by its RU unit president Golam Kibria and general secretary Faisal Ahmed Runu brought out the procession and arranged a short

rally on the campus that created panic among the admission seekers, guardians and general students, witnessed said.

Golam Kibria said they organised the programmes just to welcome the admission seekers and that was why they did not take any permission from the university authorities.

RU proctor professor Lutfor Rahman said, 'I am not

aware about the Chhatra League's programmes on the campus. We'll take action against BCL men after talking with the university authorities.'

Asking what action they had taken to prevent those programmes on campus, he said they (the proctorial body) officially asked the BCL leaders not to hold such programmes on the campus during the admission test.
