Right now, we are staring at the death of the education system and we really do not know what will happen if an entire education system dies.

However, as stated before, such a situation carries a political cost. So, it is in the interest of the present regime to at least make an effort and hand it over to a constitutional body which can at least look like it is capable of honesty in a digital Bangladesh where along with competence, honesty has become a very rare commodity.
