

# Students postpone agitations

## VC assures them of resolving crisis

STUDENTS of seven colleges affiliated with Dhaka University on Monday postponed their agitations till November 30 after the university's vice-chancellor assured them of publishing their results of honours final year exams by November this year.

Around Monday noon, a 15-member delegation of the seven colleges met with the VC, Professor Akhtaruzzaman, in his office to discuss their demands.

As Professor Akhtaruzza-

man assured them of publishing their results by November and meeting other demands gradually, they decided to postpone their agitations till November 30, said Faizur Rahman, a final year student of Kabi Nazrul College and also spokesperson of the team.

He said, 'Whereas the National University-affiliated colleges got their results published in May, the students of the seven colleges under Dhaka University are still waiting to get the results of their honours exams, which

has been holding them back from applying for jobs.'

Professor Akhtaruzzaman said that the results of second and fourth-year exams would be published by November as the university had already published the third year's exam schedule which would begin on October 23.

Akhtaruzzaman also said that the university would cooperate with the National University to resolve any prevailing issue.

The other demands of the agitating students include withdrawal of the case

against 1,200 students of the colleges, which were filed during their earlier agitation, publishing of results of second and fourth-year examinations, a new academic calendar and separate web sites for all the seven colleges.

The seven DU-affiliated colleges are Dhaka College, Eden Mohila College, Government Shaheed Subrawardy College, Kabi Nazrul Government College, Begum Badrunnesa Government Mohila College, Mirpur Government Bangla College and Government Titumir College.
