

DU students stage demo for DUCSU elections

DHAKA University students held a sit-in programme in front of the university vice-chancellor's office on the campus on Tuesday afternoon, demanding immediate initiative to hold Dhaka University Central Students Union elections.

General students of different departments of the university took part in the programme to press home their demand for DUCSU polls.

While addressing the programme, demonstrators said

that students were being deprived of their due rights because of the dysfunctional DUCSU and the absence of student representatives in the university's senate.

As per Dhaka University Ordinance 1973, elected student representatives were supposed to be in senate; but the positions remained vacant for the last 27 years, they added.

The demonstrators stated that the university authorities should declare the DUCSU election manifesto as soon as possible as the High

Court directed them to finish the process for constituting a full-fledged senate in the next six months to elect the panel for appointing its vice-chancellor.

They also threatened that they would go for a tougher movement if the authorities concerned did not pay any heed to their demand.

After the hour-long sit in programme, the demonstrators brought out a procession which paraded different streets of the campus and ended at the DUCSU building.
