

## Outcry as DU orders to end TSC activities by 8pm

A NOTICE instructing sociocultural organisations based in Dhaka University's Teacher-Student Centre to end their activities by 8:00pm on security grounds has sparked social media outcry.

The notice, signed by TSC director Mohiuddin Moyna on Tuesday and sent to all the offices housed in the centre, asked the organisations to close their activities by 8:00pm on the centre premises famous for its buzzing cultural activities.

The organisations, however, might be allowed to tice said.

DU vice-chancellor Professor Akhtaruzzaman said that the decision had been taken to ensure security and to impart more discipline to the centre.

Leaders of different organisations based in the TSC, however, said that the decision had been taken autocratically without any consultation with them.
