



DU suspends two BCL leaders for question leak

THE Dhaka University syndicate on Sunday night suspended two students, also ruling Awami League-backed student body Bangladesh Chhatra League leaders, held by Criminal Investigation Department of police for question paper leak in D'unit littake test for 2017-18 academic session.

Continued from page 1 of applied chemistry, at the university's Shahidullah Hall with electronic device on October 20.

Dhaka University Teachers Association president ASM Maksud Kamal, also a syndicate member, confirmed the news.

He said that further steps, probably expulsion of the accused students, might be taken after probe.

Earlier, BCL central committee expelled the two from the organisation following

the allegation.

Question paper of the university's 'D' unit intake test was allegedly leaked few hours before the exam while 12 admission seekers were jailed by mobile court over fraudulence during the test on October 20.

Twenty-four of the leaked questions out of 25 in the English section were found to be similar to those in the question paper distributed in the examination.

Earlier on October 26 and 27, two BCL leaders were ar-

rested for their involvement in Chittagong University admission test fraud.

Chittagong Metropolitan Police personnel held Shariful Islam alias Nazmul, an English department student and HM Ishtiaque Ahmed Sourabh, Chittagong University BCL assistant secretary and a student of marketing department, on allegation of admission test fraud.

CU authorities on Friday suspended Ishtiaque and Shariful.
