

# Primary, junior school results today

RESULTS of primary and ibtedayi education completion examinations, and junior school certificate and junior dakhil certificate examinations will be published today.

Education minister Nurul Islam Nahid will formally announce the results of JSC and JDC examinations at 12:00pm at a press conference in his secretariat office.

Primary and mass education minister Mostafizur Rahman will brief the media on highlights of primary and ibtedayi completion results at 1:00pm.

Prior to that, copies of the

results will be handed over to prime minister Sheikh Hasina.

Examinees will be able to get their results at their respective schools. Results will also be available on web sites of respective boards and directorate, and through SMS.

Primary students will get results on the web sites of primary education directorate: [www.dpe.gov.bd](http://www.dpe.gov.bd) and <http://dpe.teletalk.com.bd>, while the JSC and JDC students can get their results at [www.educationboardresults.gov.bd](http://www.educationboardresults.gov.bd).

Over 32 lakh class V students took part in this year's primary and ibtedayi educa-

tion completion examinations, while more than 24 lakh class VIII students took part in junior school certificate and junior dakhil certificate examinations.

This year's JSC and JDC examinations were held in November 1-17 and primary examinations in November 20-27 respectively.

In 2015, the pass rate in JSC under eight general education boards stood at 92.31 per cent. The pass rate in JDC under madrassah education board stood at 92.46 per cent.

In the same year, the pass rate in primary schools was 98.52, while the pass rate in madrassahs was 95.13.
