RESULTS of the Higher Secondary Certificate and its equivalent examinations will be published today.

Education minister Nurul Islam Nahid will first hand over the results to prime minister, Sheikh Hasina, at Prime Minister's Office at 10am, education ministry deputy principal information officer Saifullah told New Age on Wednesday.

Nahid will hold a briefing at the ministry at 1pm.

The results will be available at colleges at 2pm. Students can check their results at www.educationboardresults.gov.bd. They can also get the results by sending text messages to mobile operators, with a charge.

The exams were held between April 3 and June 22.

About 12.19 lakh examinees took HSC and equivalent exams this year. Of the students, about 10.20 lakh students took the HSC exam under eight general education boards and some 91,600 students appeared in Alim exam under the madrassah board, while one lakh students sat for business management exam under the technical board.

In 2015, combined pass rate was 69.60, and pass percentage in Higher Secondary Certificate and equivalent examinations fell to its eight-year low.
