Results of over 14,000 SSC examinees changed in Ctg

836 more SSC examinees secured GPA-5

EIGHT hundred and thirty-six more examinees secured GPA-5 after re-scrutiny of mathematics answer scripts in SSC examination 2016 under Chittagong Educational Board.

The grade points of 14,158 examinees were changed after the re-examination. Three examinees who failed in previous result passed after re-examination.

The re-examined results were published on Wednesday, said Mahbub Hasan, examination controller of the board.

As many as 7,666 students secured the highest Grade Point Average (GPA-5) in SSC results that were published on May 11 but now the total number of GPA -5 achievers is 8,502.

The board later re-examined the objective answer sheets of mathematics as it was demanded by some examinees.

The board sources said the number of golden GPA-5 achievers (GPA-5 in all subjects) also increased to 1,115 from 991.
