

BCL activists beat SAU student for comment on PM

ACTIVISTS of Bangladesh Chhatra League, ruling Awami League-backed student organisation, on Tuesday beat a student to injure allegedly for a comment on prime minister Sheikh Hasina on his facebook status at Sylhet Agricultural University.

The university sources said Shahed Redwan, a 3rd year agricultural engineering and technology student, wrote a comment on his facebook status on Rampal issue, in which he addressed the prime minister Sheikh Hasina as a 'Jatiya Boni' (national sister).

A group of BCL activists led by Anup Chowdhury along with Tanvir Islam and Rezaul Karim attacked Redwan around 2:30pm on the university campus claiming that the comment was 'ridiculous' and it hurt the sentiment of the prime minister's fans and supporters.

Redwan was admitted to Sylhet Osmani Medical College Hospital.

The university proctor Mahfuzur Rashid told New Age that he heard the incident but nobody filed any complaint in this regard. ||
