

3,683 applicants qualify in JnU 'B' unit test

THE Jagannath University authorities on Monday published the results of 'B' unit admission test for 2016-17 academic sessions under arts faculty, law faculty and institute of education and research.

JnU vice-chancellor Mijanur Rahman unveiled the results at his office in the afternoon.

The results were made available on the university notice boards and also on the JnU website: www.jnu.ac.bd or www.result.jnu.ac.bd.

Only 3,683 candidates qualified out of 34,150 aspirants who appeared in the intake test, 'B' unit and 'E' unit admission test coordinator Mohammad Salim told New Age.

He said a total of 36,225 admission seekers applied online for the test against 670 seats under different departments of the unit.

The students were required to score minimum 30 marks to pass the 72-mark test for 'B' unit. The test was held in 15 centres on and off the campus on September 23.

Meanwhile, a total of 480 aspirants qualified in admission test of 'E' unit held on the campus on September 24 while around 1,622 appeared in the test. Admission seekers into music department, theatre department and fine arts department took the test under 'E' unit.

Last year, 4,577 candidates succeeded in the 'B' unit test out of nearly 37,811 examinees for 720 seats in 2015-16 academic sessions.
