

JnU students demand increased transport, library facilities

THE Jagannath University students formed a human chain on the campus on Monday, demanding that the authorities should increase transport and library facilities for them.

JnU unit of the Samajtantrik Chhatra Front, a left-leaning student organi-

zation, organised the programme.

Demonstrators said the university authorities failed to provide sufficient transport facility for the students.

Only seven per cent students were getting the transport facility, they said.

Despite scarcity of books in the university library, the authorities did not take any

effective steps, they said.

Around 99 per cent students were deprived of the e-library facility as it remained open only during the class time, they added.

They urged the authorities to keep the library open from 8:00am to 8:00pm.

Later, they brought out a procession on the campus to press home their demand.
