

## BCL INFIGHTING *KMC temporarily expels four students, bans student politics on campus*

THE Khulna Medical College authority on Sunday expelled four students, all leaders and activists of ruling Awami League's student front Bangladesh Chattra League, temporarily, and banned student politics on campus.

The expelled students are former KMC unit BCL president Saifullah Mansur and activists Safiul Islam, Anindya Sunder and Md Rasel.

'The decision was taken at the college's academic council meeting following a clash of two groups of students,' KMC principal Abdullah Al Mahbub said.

He said that they had formed a three-member committee to probe the incident and asked the committee to submit the report between seven and fifteen days.

Academic activities remained halted as the students did not attend the scheduled classes and examinations, sources among officials in the college said.

On Saturday, about 50 students, almost all of them BCL members, were injured in a clash between two groups of KMC BCL - one led by Saifullah Mansur and the other led by Saidur Rahman Tito - on KMC campus on Saturday.

Sonadanga police station officer-in-charge Sukumar Biswas told New Age that six cases were filed in connection with the clash and extra police forces were deployed on campus to avoid any further untoward incident.
