

'Human chain' demands KU teacher removal

KHULNA University's electronics and communication engineering discipline students on Sunday formed a human chain on the campus demanding immediate removal of head of the discipline Professor Dr Sehrish Khan.

All 227 students of the discipline spontaneously participated in the programme.

The students alleged that the head of the discipline was 'insolent, inexperienced, and irresponsible by nature'.

'Her indecorous behaviour towards the students has crossed all limits of tolerance', said Faisal Kabir, a third year student of the discipline, who was leading this movement against the discipline head.

We demand her immediate removal for the greater interest of the university and also for our better academic career, Kabir added while addressing the human chain.

Contacted, Professor Dr Sehrish Khan denying these allegations claimed that she had fallen victim to internal conspiracy by a group of misguided teachers who did not want her to stay in the University.

The 'misguided teachers' were inciting the innocent students to wage movement against her and tarnishing the university image.

Asked, the university vice-chancellor Professor Dr Md Fayek-Uz-Zaman said that he would sit with all the conflicting parties very soon to solve the problem.
